## ABOUT THIS WINE

Viognier is a grape varietal very well suited to the dry-land conditions in the Swartland. Originally from the South of France where conditions are similarly dry and warm, Viognier thrives here. The wine is aromatic and expressive with floral aromas complemented by peach and apricot fruit flavours. Unwooded with a lively acidity this wine is refreshingly light and crisp.

## VINIFICATION WINEMAKER'S NOTE

To ensure an array of layered fruit flavours and to capture freshness, we use only free run juice and temperature control a slow, cool fermentation. The wine is then left on the fine lees before bottling to preserve freshness.

Floral aromas with hints of peach & apricot balanced by a crisp, dry finish.
